The Council on Standards for International Educational Travel is proud to present the 4th Annual Global Classroom Awards to recognize schools that actively support international youth exchange.

Far-sighted educators and generous high schools are fundamental components of international exchange. Exchange could never have the life-changing impact it so often does without the enthusiastic collaboration of schools.

While every relationship is important, there are some schools that create a unique climate of support for exchange students by making global issues a focus of the entire school. These schools help make exchange a truly thrilling one for international students, the student body, and the community at large.

Please nominate a school that has promoted school-wide feelings of inclusiveness and global curiosity while hosting international exchange students or encouraging their students to travel and study abroad.

The awards will be given out in person to a representative of the school during the 2011 National School Conference on International Youth Exchange. All winners must be present to receive the award. Each winner will receive airfare, one night's accommodation and free registration for the conference for one representative from the school.

Each winner will be invited to take part in a School Outreach Committee activity of CSIET in the year following the award.

NOMINATION

Nominations must include:

A completed application form and a **one-page typed** essay of why the nominated school should be selected. Each essay must include real examples of the school's commitment to multiculturalism and international exchange. Be sure to include **specific examples** of how the school has encouraged international awareness, either by welcoming exchange students or by promoting study abroad opportunities for its students.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Nominees will be judged based on:

- Demonstrable commitment to promoting global understanding and international exchange.
- Evidence of creativity, enthusiasm, and dedication in welcoming exchange students or encouraging their local students to study abroad.

AWARD

The winning schools will each receive a \$500 scholarship for one of its students to study abroad or equivalent funds to be put toward increasing school-wide international awareness. One representative from each of the winning schools will be invited to the 2011 National School Conference and receive complementary registration, one night accommodation, and airfare.
