Introduction

The Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) annually evaluates U.S.-based youth exchange programs to ensure compliance with CSIET Standards, so that students, families, and schools can identify reputable exchange organizations.

CSIET collects student numbers from exchange organizations voluntarily applying for listing in the *Advisory List*. This report provides international youth exchange statistics from the 2005-2006 academic cycle.

The first part of this report provides data tables for each category of exchange activity. The second half includes graphics to provide a comparative perspective.

Please note that since not all U.S.-based exchange organizations apply for CSIET listing, the statistics in this document do not include every existing U.S. Exchange Organization. However, they do reflect the vast majority of the field.

Additionally, the accuracy of the data collected relies on the data as presented by applicant youth programs and is not externally verified by CSIET.





Terminology

Since the statistics in this document were based on exchanges conducted by U.S.-based exchange programs, “**Inbound**” is used to describe a program that brings students *into the* United States.

Likewise, “**Outbound**” is used to describe a program that sends American students *out of* the United States.

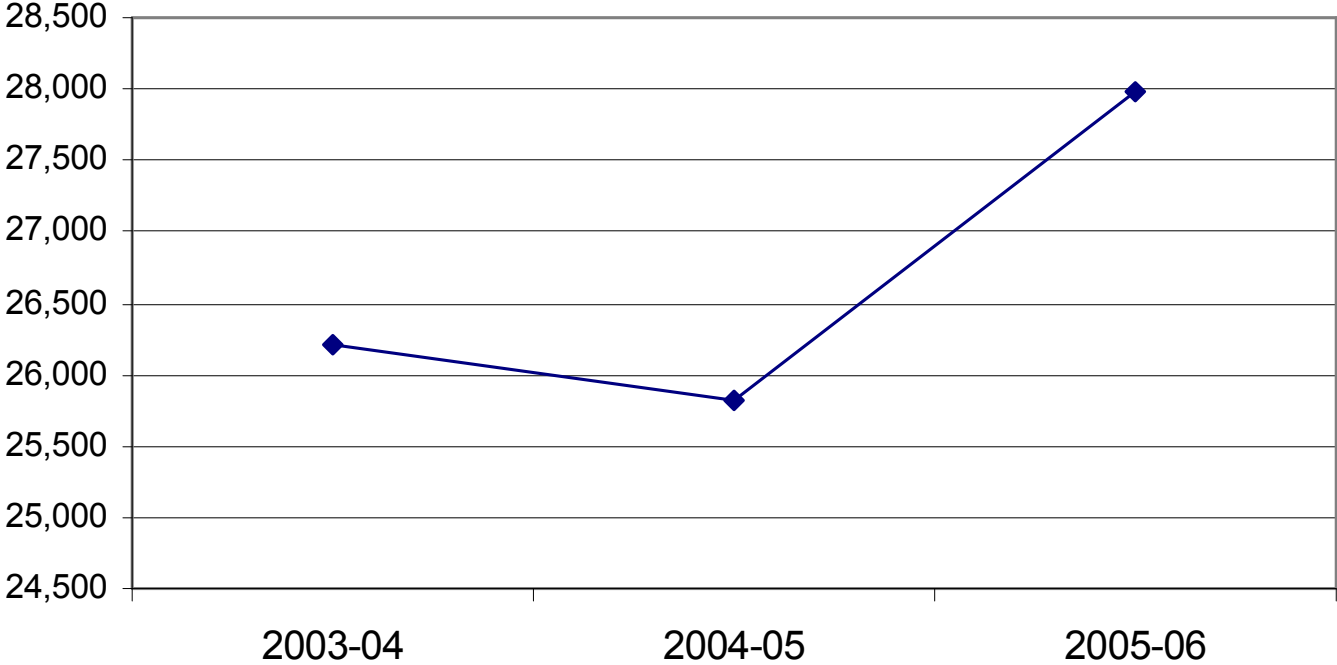

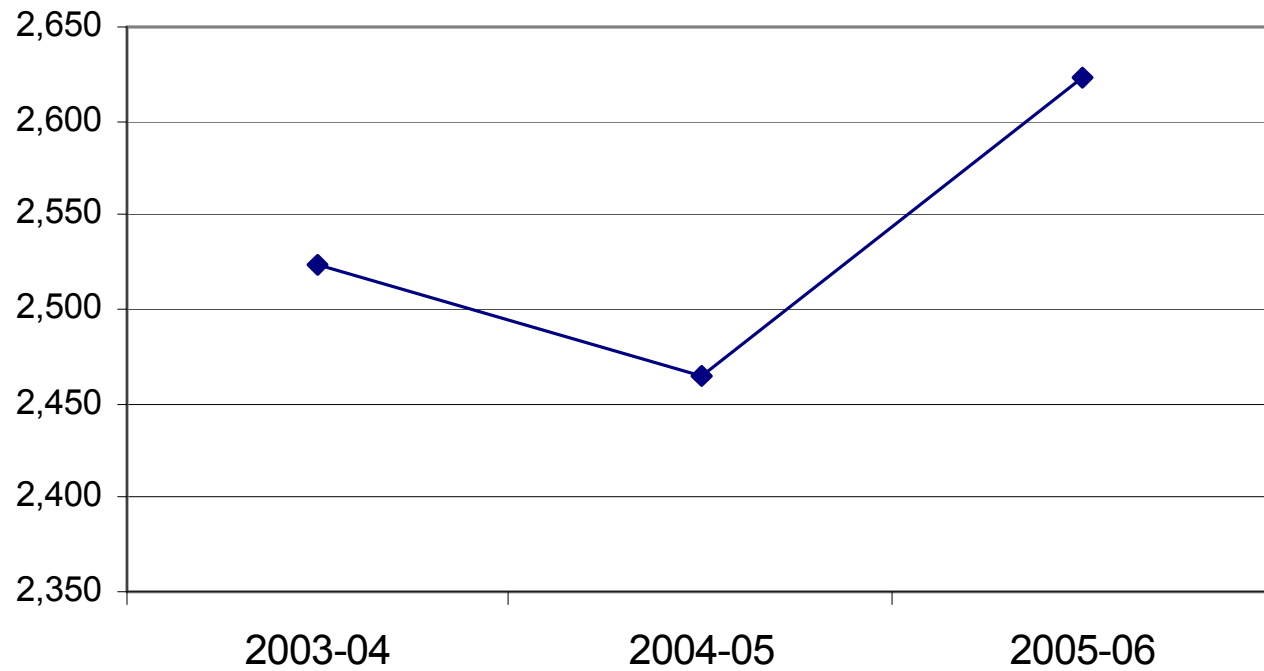

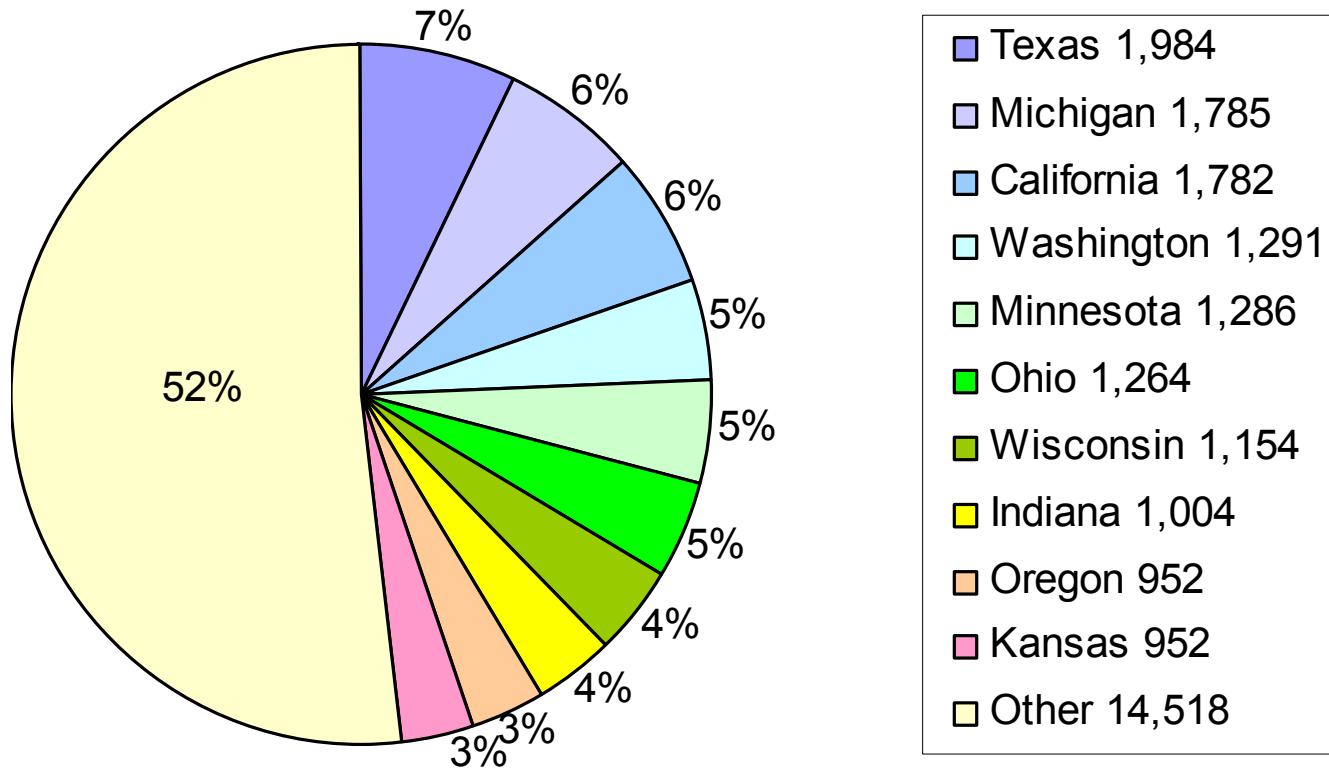

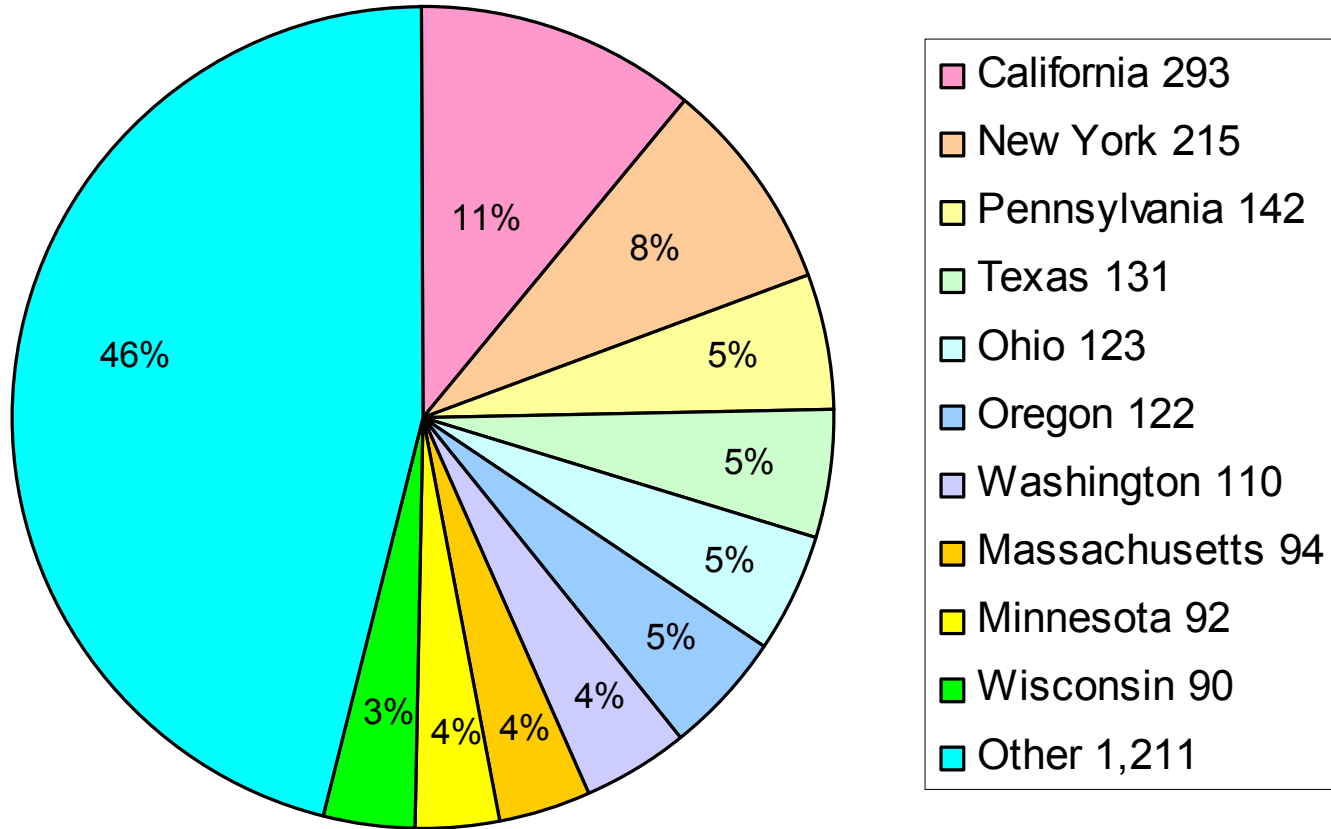
3-Year Comparison: U.S. Students on Exchange



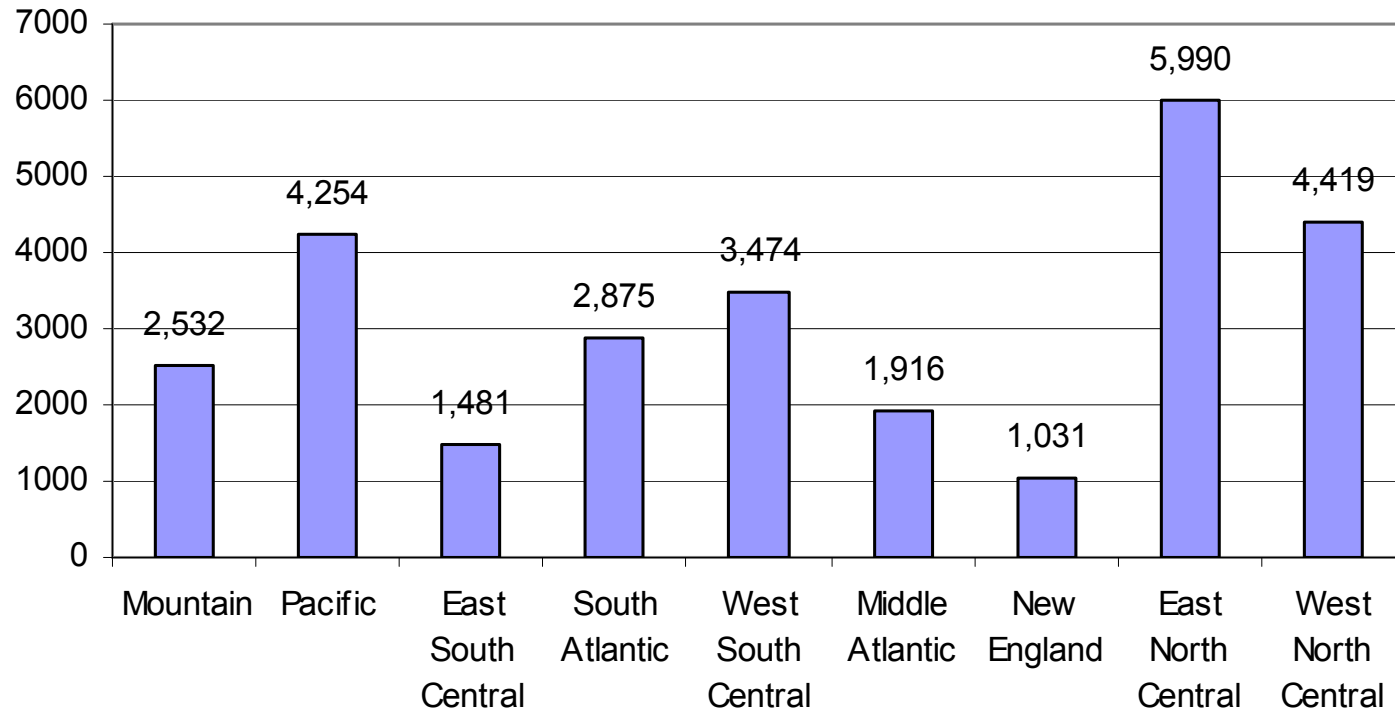
Top 10 U.S. States Hosting Exchange Students



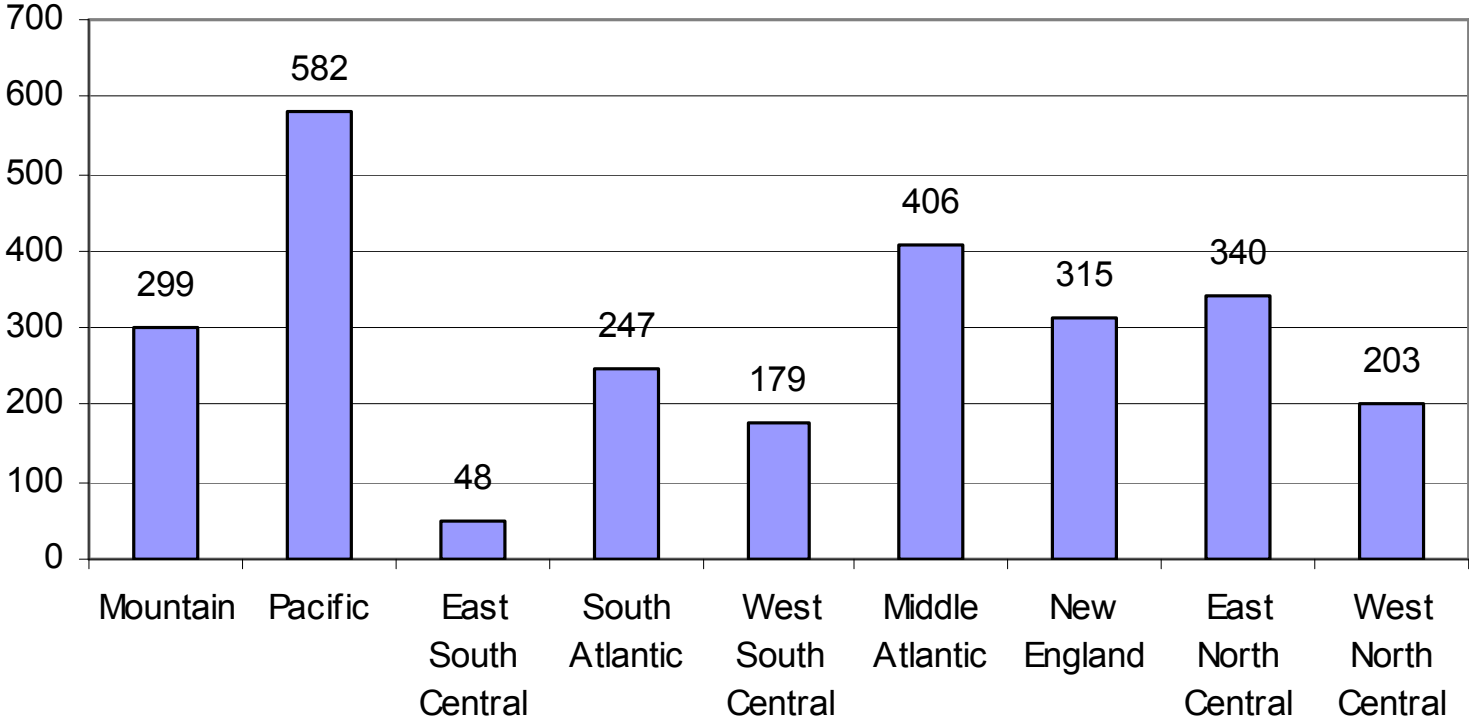
Top 10 U.S. States Sending Students Abroad



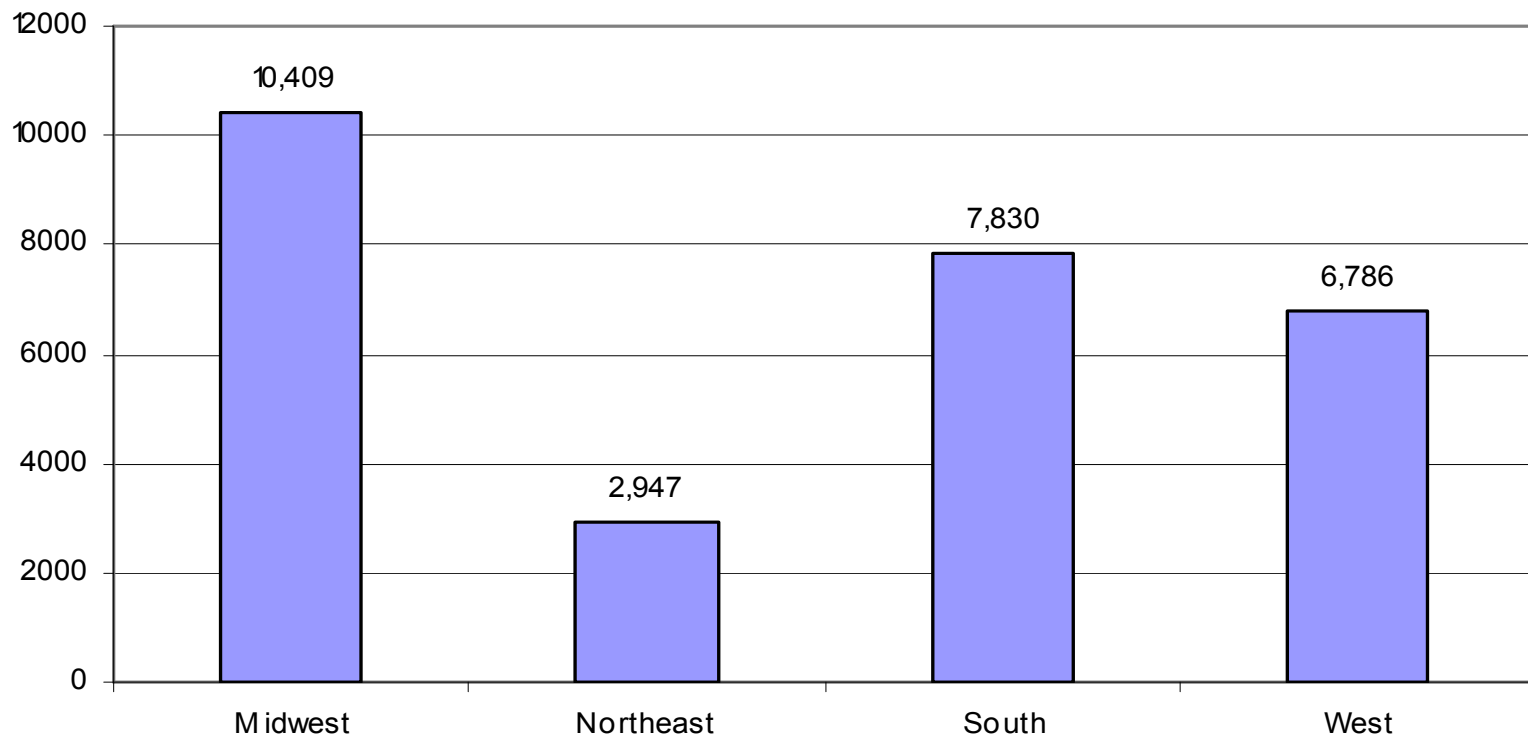
Hosting of Exchange Students by U.S. Division



Sending of Students Abroad by U.S. Division

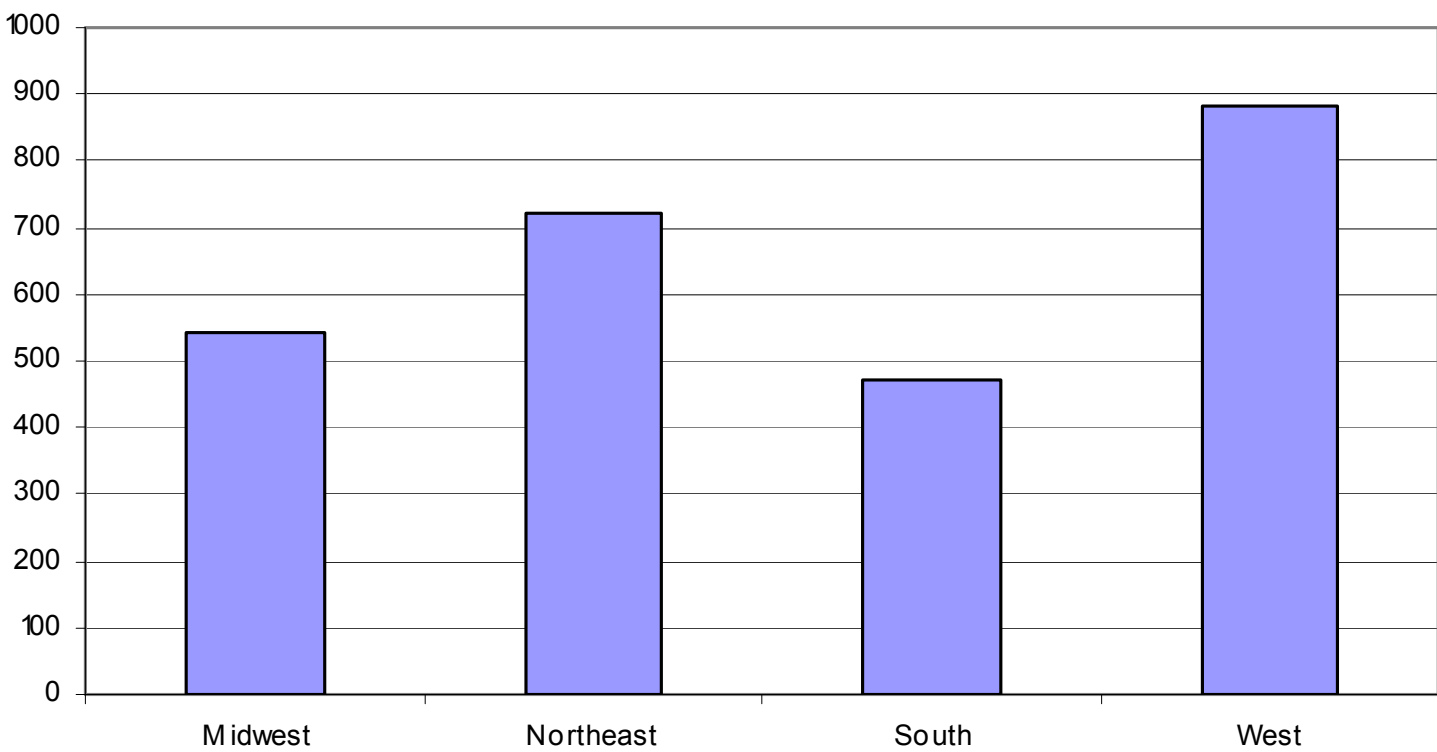


Hosting of Exchange Students by U.S. Region

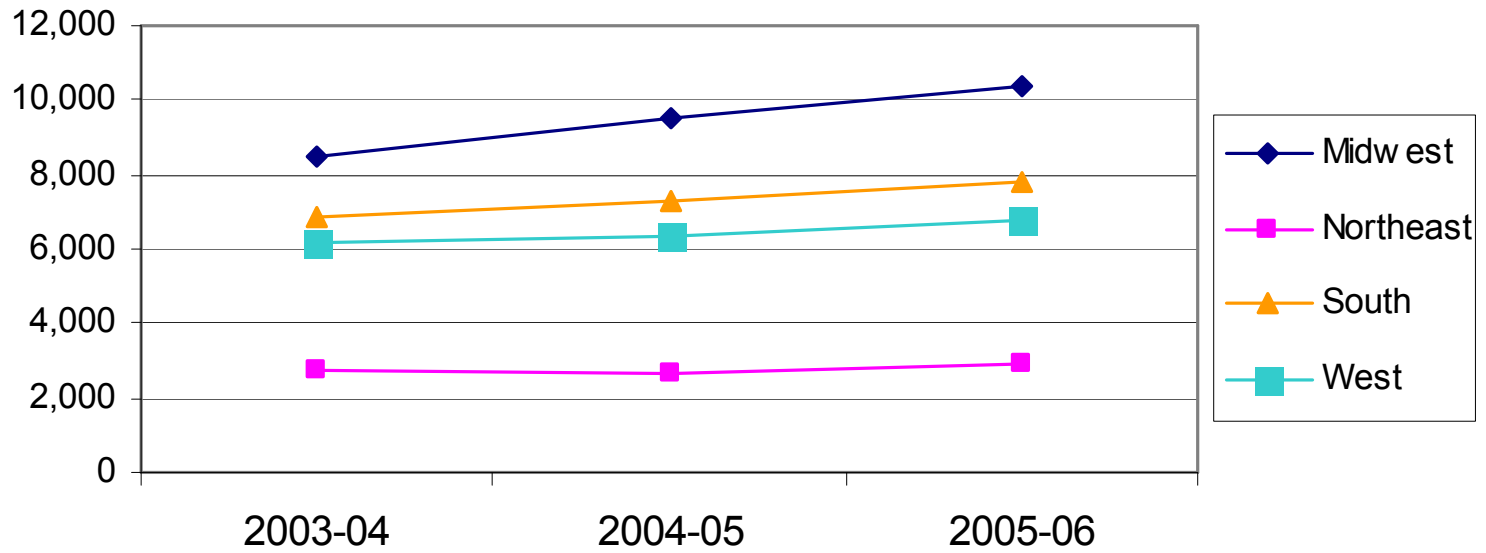




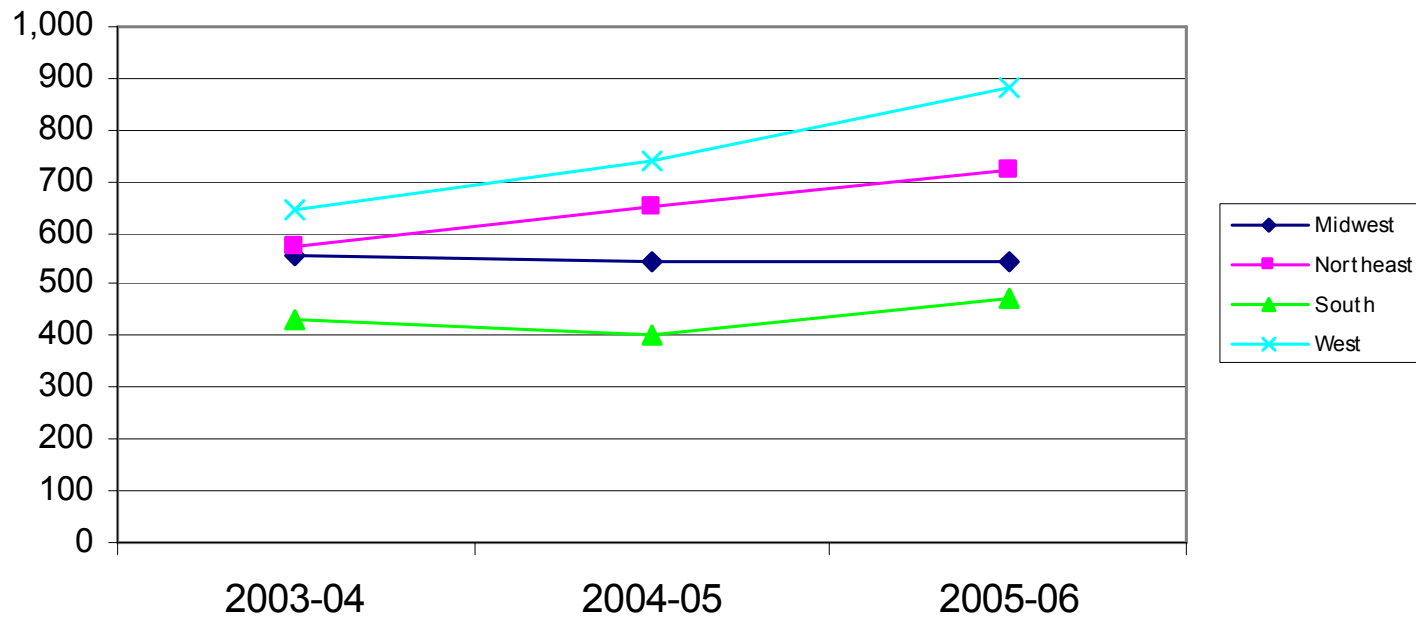

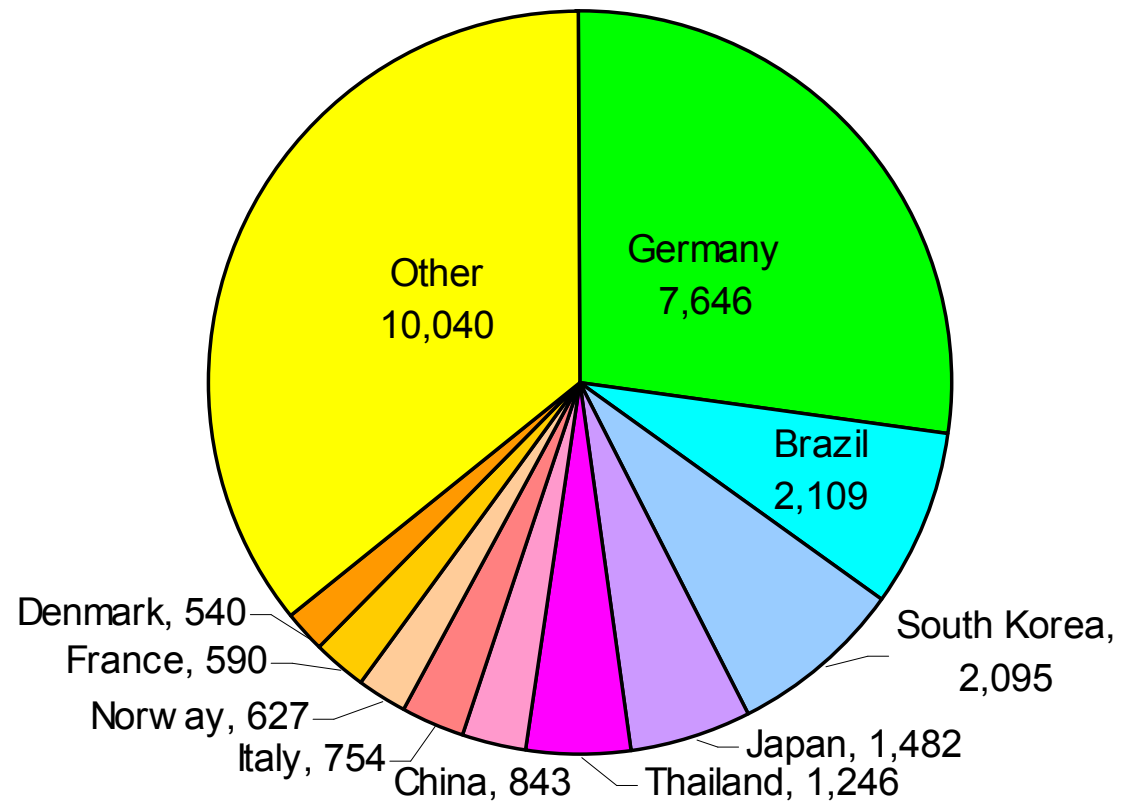
3-Year Comparison: U.S. Regions Hosting Exchange Students



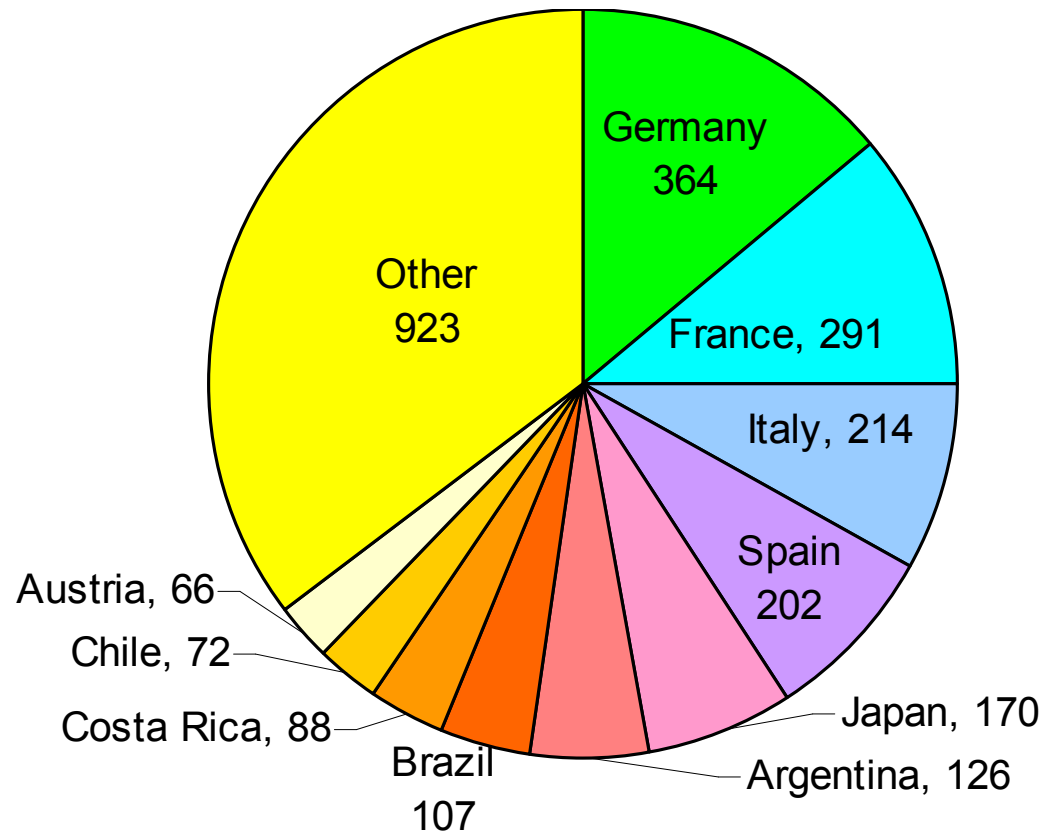
3-Year Comparison: U.S. Regions Sending Students Abroad



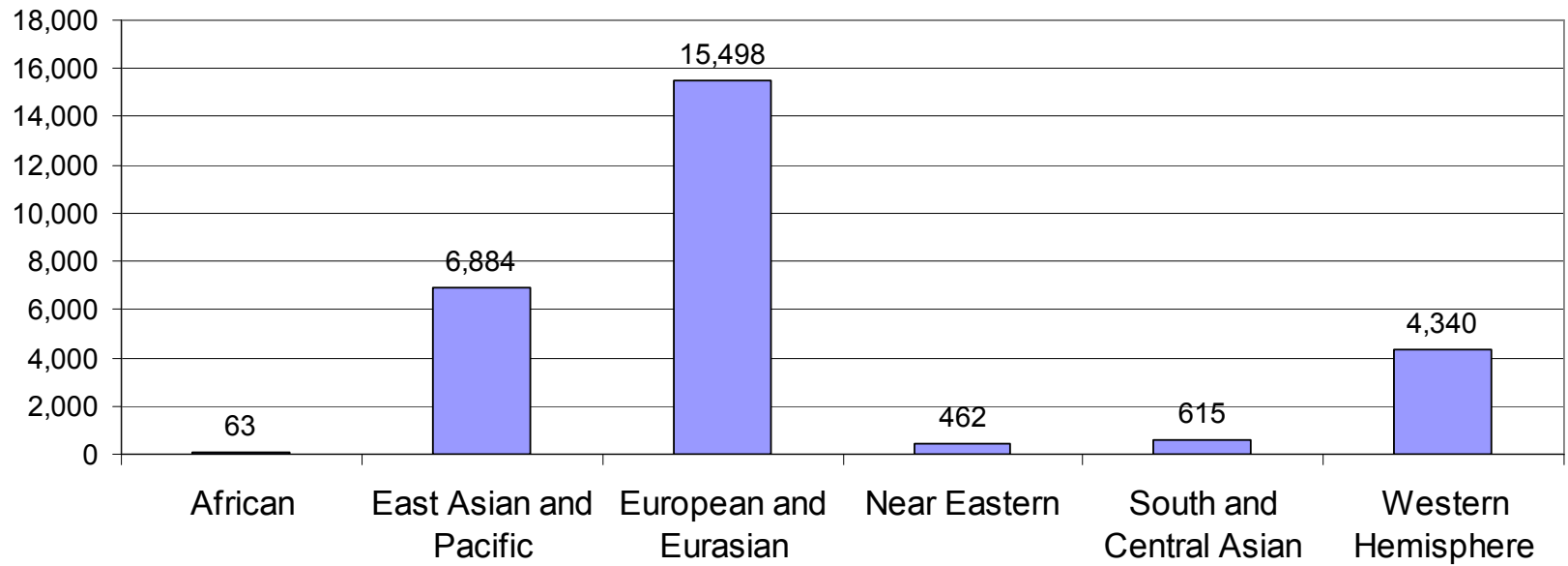
Top 10 Countries Sending Students to U.S.



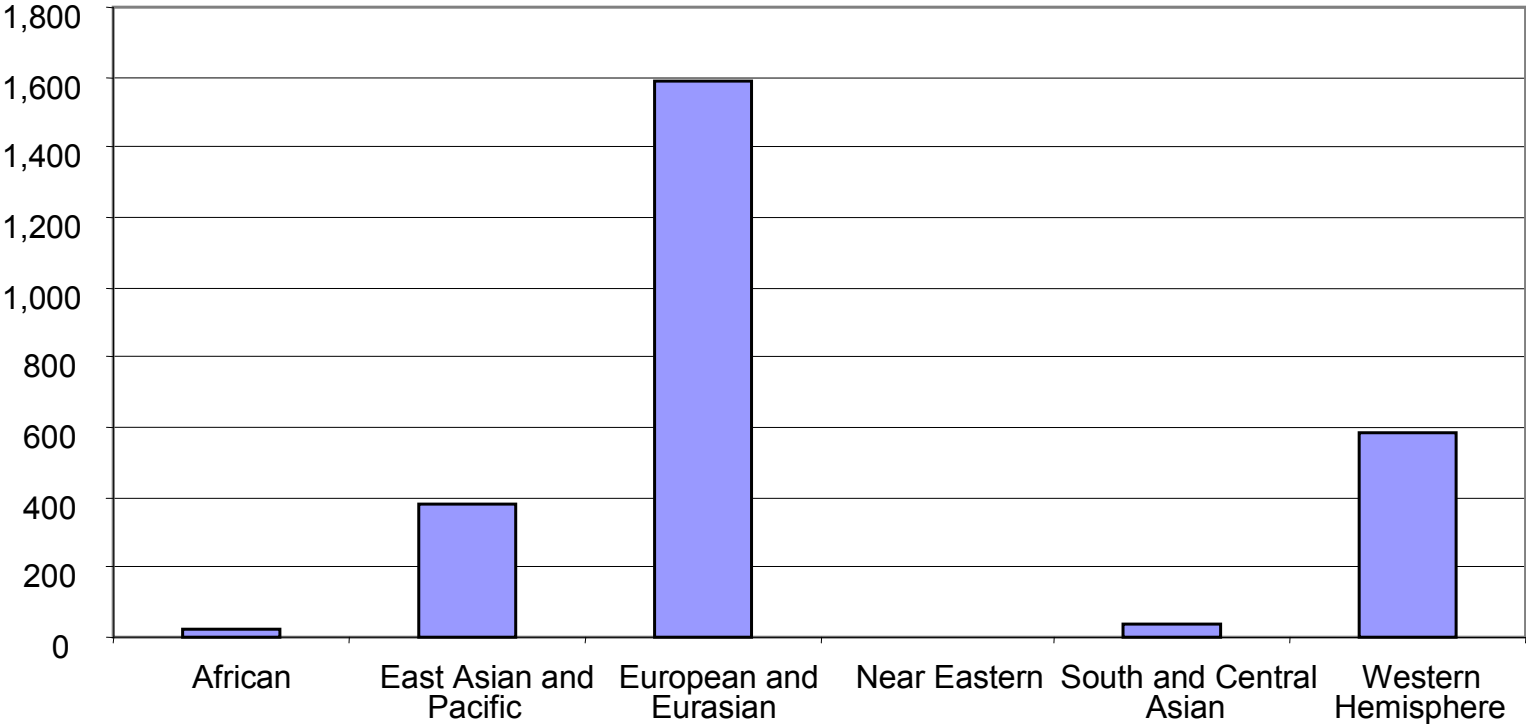
Top 10 Countries Hosting U.S. Students



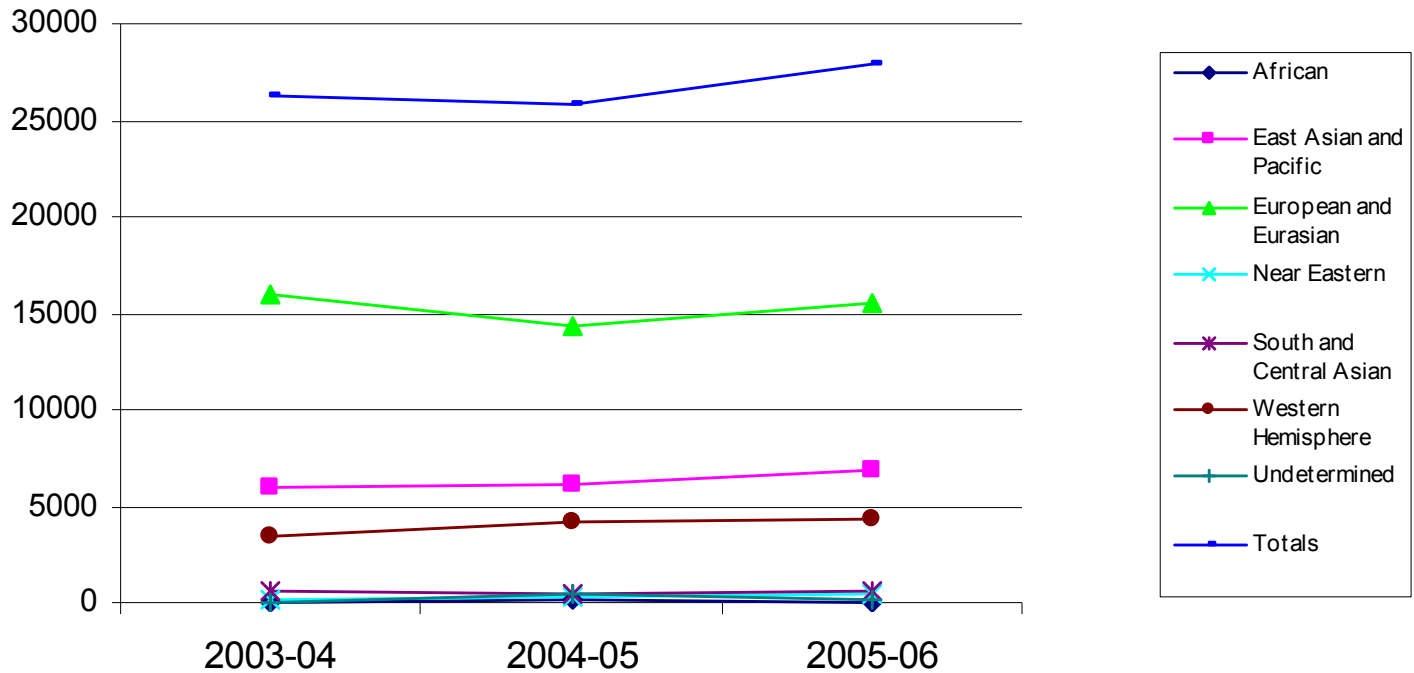
World Regions Sending Students to U.S.
